Dear Parents,

Next half term your child will be once again participating in their Forest School sessions with Mrs. Farrington. Forest School sessions will take place each Thursday afternoon, commencing on the 12th January until 16th February inclusive.

Forest School sessions go ahead in all weathers (with the exception of heavy winds and thunder storms). To make the most of their experience it is essential that everyone is properly dressed for the weather conditions, and as we are entering into the coldest time of year it is crucial that the children wear:

- Trousers and warm long sleeved tops, layers are best in the cold weather
- Hats and gloves (not mittens)
- Wellingtons or other sturdy boots with warm socks
- Waterproof trousers and jacket

Please use old clothes and let your child know that at Forest School they <u>CAN GET DIRTY</u> and you don't mind! As the comfort and well being of your child is paramount to us, any child not suitably dressed for one of their sessions will be unable to attend.

Children attending Forest School sessions can come to school dressed in their Forest School clothes and should bring their waterproofs and wellies in a named carrier bag.
