Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to you to share some very exciting news about a new day that we are planning to build in to our school calendar this year. One of our main targets of our school improvement plan includes developing pupils understanding and recognition into how to lead healthy lifestyles. Whilst this covers main different elements, we would like to raise the opportunities of all children in terms of playing competitive sport.

Therefore, we have planned an intra-school sponsored sports day for our children on Thursday 23rd May 2019 with the Friday 24th being the reserve date should we have incremental weather.

Children will be representing their house teams of Trent, Claymills, Sinai and Rosliston for the day and they will be encouraged to wear sporting clothes in the colours of their house team.
