Dear Parents,

As many of you are aware, the children in Year 6 have the opportunity at this stage of the year to plan, organise and run their own Year 6 Enterprise Fair, which will be held on Monday 15th July 2019. The children are involved in selecting the sort of stalls and entertainment that they think the children from Nursery through to Year 5 will enjoy. Year 6 are of course raising money, which this year they have decided will go to Dementia UK.

The Year 6 pupils have selected their own choice of stall and have been deciding on the price of their chosen area. May I point out that the emphasis is not on raising huge amounts of money, but on Year 6 pupils having responsibility for this event and the rest of the school fully participating in it and enjoying it. With this in mind, the price of the stalls will not be huge and no more than £2 will really be necessary per child (preferably in change to help out the Year 6 pupils). Therefore, can I please ask you to send some money in with your child in a named purse/envelope on the morning of the fair?

The children have all written a short piece which provides some information about their stall or activity. They have also included information regarding donations, which will be greatly appreciated.
