We are pleased to announce that a wide range of extra-curricular activities will be made available for the children to participate in during the first half of the Summer Term. The club programme will begin w/c Monday 25th April 2022 and finish w/e Friday 20th May 2022 (unless otherwise stated). We are fortunate indeed to have such a dedicated team of staff who are willing to undertake these activities voluntarily, for the benefit of the children. We are grateful to them all for their hard work and continued support. We are truly proud that we are able to offer such a wide variety of clubs from a relatively small number of teaching staff.

I am sure parents will agree that the wide range of options available to the children are indeed very comprehensive for a school of our size. The list, which follows, outlines the activities, which may be undertaken by your child.

Having received positive feedback from the Eventbrite booking system we trialed last time we will continue to use this method for parents to book their child(ren) onto these sessions. Parents will again be emailed a link to each activity their child is eligible to attend via Eventbrite. Click on the link and book a ticket (there is no cost) to just the **first** session, when all available places have been booked there will be no further tickets available so it will be done on a **first come first served basis - book from 5pm today**. A ticket for the first session will mean your child has a place for each of the 4 weeks. This will again reduce volume of paper used, thus making school more sustainable and reduce time lost in collating the paper slips.

Please book a place for your child(ren) on these activities by FRIDAY 8TH APRIL 2022 deadline.

This will also help us to ascertain if there are any surplus places available, in which case other children will be given the opportunity to attend. Should the club be cancelled you will be informed via text message or telephone with as much advance notice as possible. Once your child has committed him or herself to join a club it is imperative that they attend each session. Should a child be unable to attend a club for any particular reason parents are asked to notify school.
