

Dear Parents/Carers,

It is with regret that I must inform you that I will be absent from school for a period due to an upcoming surgery. The staff will keep you informed of any updates or changes through our regular communication channels, and I hope to see as many of you as possible this week on the gate to wish you well for Christmas before I go for surgery. I am keeping everything crossed for a speedy recovery!
