What a busy week we have had in Nursery, completing lots of learning based on the story of the Gingerbread Man.

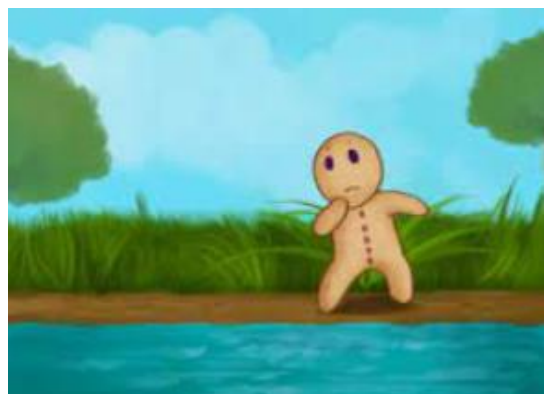
We had great fun placing a Gingerbread Man biscuit into water to see what would happen if he had swam across the river, instead of taking a ride from the sly fox! This generated lots of lovely vocabulary such as soggy, mushy and sloppy! This learning also led us on to thinking about objects that float and those that sink, and we began some simple experiments in Nursery to find out more.

For home learning this week, we would like you to continue to explore the concept of floating and sinking. During bath time or water play at the sink, collect a range of different objects and get your child to predict what will happen first before placing them in the water. Talk about what they see happening, for example, did an object sink quickly or slowly, does it float on top of the water or just below the surface.
