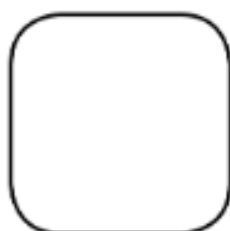

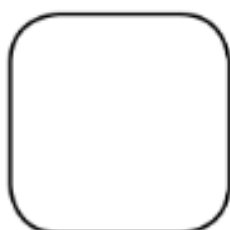

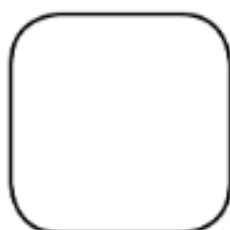
Stripes



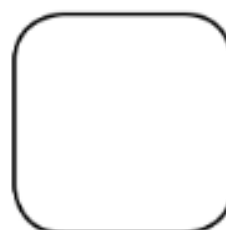
Zig Zags



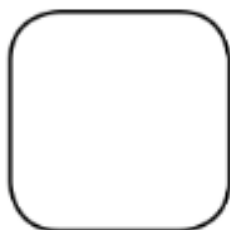

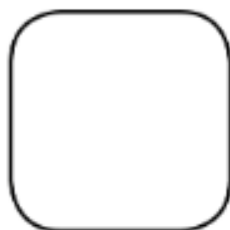

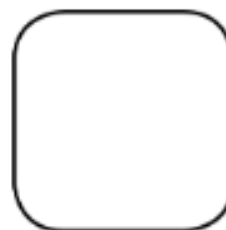
