**Please return homework by Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> February**

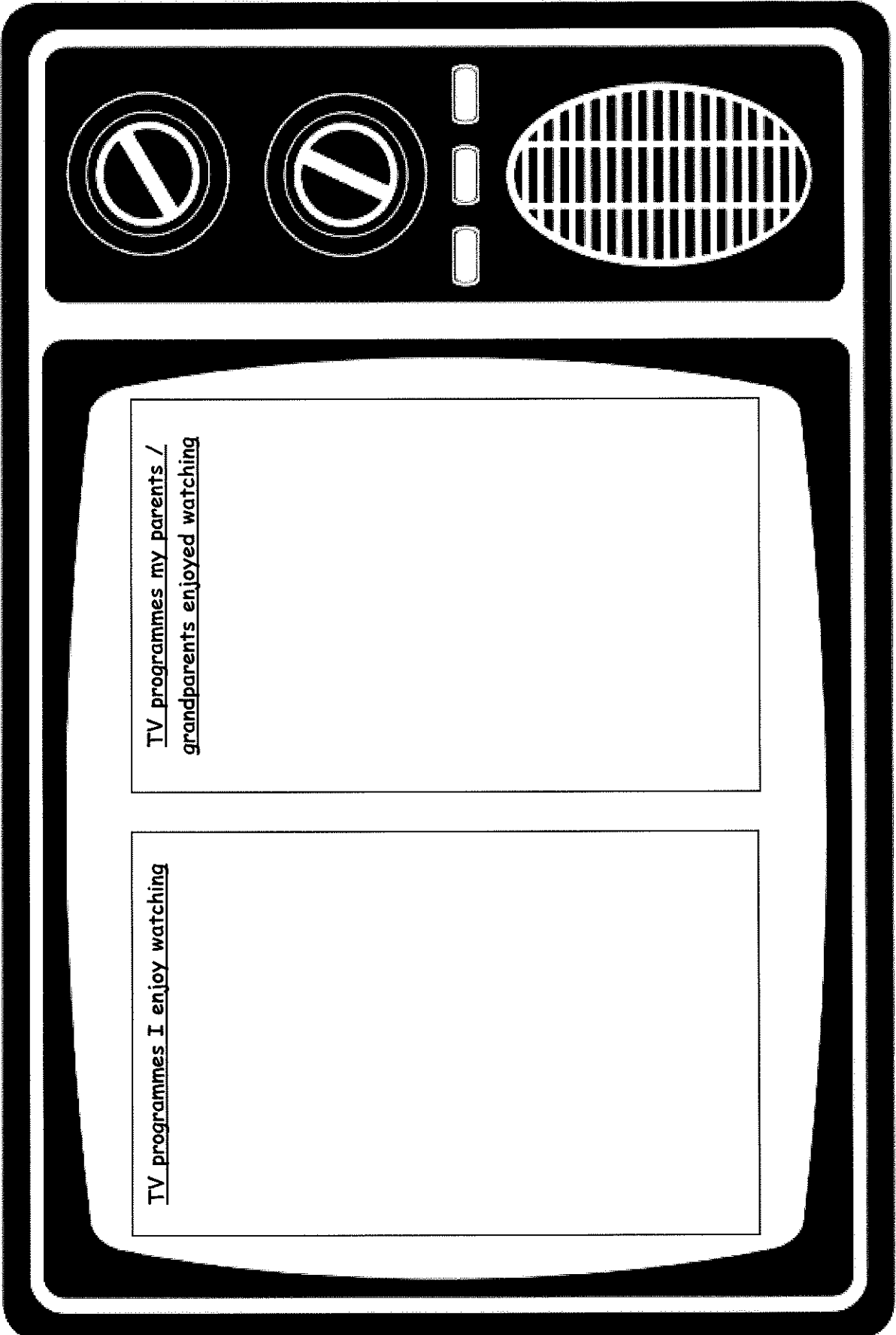
