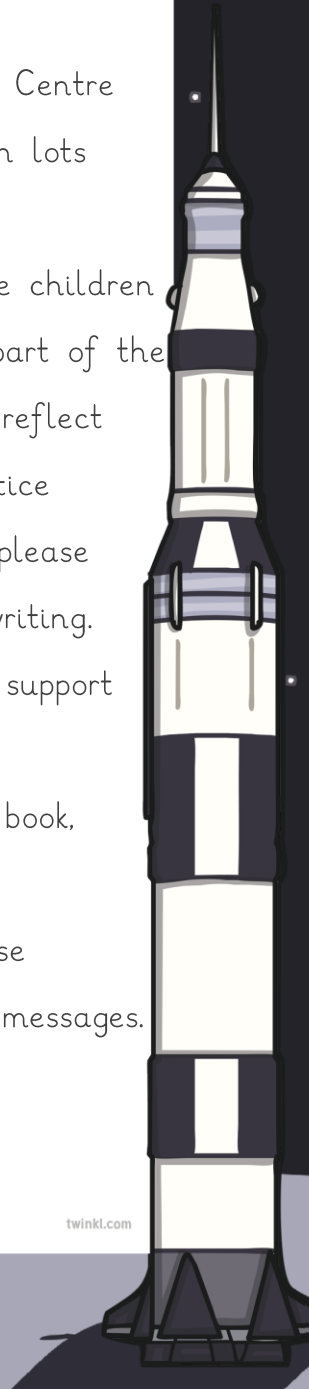
The children have enjoyed a trip to the Space Centre today. I am sure they have returned home with lots to talk about.
