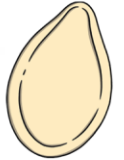

The children have been learning about growing plants and after sharing the story Jack and the Beanstalk we decided to plant our own beans!



Today the children have added beans to cotton wool and will observe changes over the next weeks. Your child has brought their bean home today along with a diary to record their observations. **Please can diaries be returned the week beginning 29<sup>th</sup> April- plants do not need to be returned.**



Please encourage your child to complete the diary by drawing pictures and adding labels to show the equipment they used and what a plant needs to grow. Each week talk to your child about what they notice about their beanstalk!



Are there any changes?  
Can they describe the changes?  
Can they name the different parts of the plant?  
What are their predictions?



I wonder if they will grow as high as Jacks?



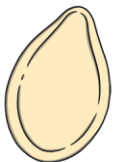
They can draw pictures, add photographs- these can be sent via Evidence Me and I will happily print them and send them home so you can add them to your child's diary.
