The children have had a fabulous time exploring the famous painting 'Irises,' by Vincent Van Gogh.

To develop their creativity further I would like them to use the painting as inspiration to create their own Irises!

Rather than replicating blue Irises, I would like them to change the blue flowers to a colour of their choice. They could use paints, crayons, pencils, pastels etc. Encourage them to think carefully about the shapes as we have been linking this to symmetry. Also discuss colours (light and dark) and lines.
