
Mathematics

Maths presents itself throughout the day across all areas of learning and in our daily routines such as daily calendar, stories and rhymes.

Our Maths learning for this half term will be:

- To identify, and compare circles and triangles
- To identify shapes in the environment.
- To describe position.
- To find, represent and subitise 4 and 5.
- To recognise the composition of 1-4.
- To identify one more and one less.
- To identify and combine shapes with 4 sides.
- To explore day and night.

- $\bullet \text{Listen}$ to stories and answer simple questions about the text.
- Connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will be encouraged to explore a range of resources and techniques to develop creative skills.

Skills and knowledge we will be learning....

- Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills.
- Discuss the characteristics of a range of sounds and describe how they makes them feel using recently introduced words.
- Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody.
- Return to and build on their previous learning, refining ideas and developing their ability to represent them.

Literacy

We will be exploring a range of stories and non-fiction texts this half term that are linked to our topic. We will have a daily phonics session focussing on Phase 2 and 3 of Little Wandle. Skills and knowledge we will be learning...

- Complete reading practice sessions in small groups 3 times a week to develop decoding, prosody and comprehension.
- Through talk for writing explore the story 'Whatever Next.'
- Re-enact a variety of different rhymes, poems and songs using a selection of props.
- Write simple labels for familiar objects within their classroom environment (e.g. pen, peg).
- Use Little Wandle phrases and refer to phonics dispalys to form graphemes correctly.
