English	<p><b><u>Reading</u></b> Read at home on at least <b>three</b> separate occasions. Reading diaries will arrive shortly as there has been a delay with the publisher.</p> <p><b><u>Spellings</u></b> In order to promote spelling both in school and at home, we are involved in an online programme called 'Spelling Shed' it is important that you practise your spellings on a <b>daily basis</b>. Using your child's login details, which are stuck in their homework book. The children are given a sheet each week which has all 10 words on for that spelling rule and an activity. To support your child's transition into Year 1 they will only be tested on the words which have been highlighted by the star (This week it will be 6 spellings).
