English	<p><u>Reading</u> Read at home on at least three separate occasions. Reading diaries will arrive shortly as there has been a delay with the publisher.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> In order to promote spelling both in school and at home, we are involved in an online programme called 'Spelling Shed' it is important that you practise your spellings on a daily basis. Using your child's login details, which are stuck in their homework book. The children are given a sheet each week which has all 10 words on for that spelling rule and an activity. To support your child's transition into Year 1 they will only be tested on the words which have been highlighted by the star (This week it will be 5 spellings). They will have a test every Friday. Using your child's login details, which are stuck in their homework book. Revise your subitising on www.numbots.com Number formation is being sent home for the children to practise as they seem to be finding this a little tricky to remember.</p>
