Year 4 Multiplication Check

In June 2022, all children in Year 4 will have a multiplication check which will take place in school to test their knowledge of times tables up to 12x12. The pupils will have 25 questions but only six seconds to answer each question, therefore it is very important the children learn each times table thoroughly. In order to prepare for this, children are learning a times table each week for homework but they also need to recap on old times tables too.
