Dear Parents,

I hope you have all enjoyed the holidays and your child is ready to get back into the routines of school. Just a few things I want to let you know about for this academic year. We are very lucky in Year 5 to still be working with Mr Rowley and Mrs Riley, whom your children know very well.

Your child will need their swimming kit in school on Tuesdays as they will go every week starting on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> September. Whenever they are not swimming they will be doing PE so please make sure your child's kit is in school for those days.

Please support your child with reading by listening to them read and sign their diaries at least three times per week. This will help your child access the wider curriculum. Like Year 4, pupils will continue to take part in a times tables test and also 33 Club which will also take part on a Friday. Usually, homework will have to be handed in on Wednesdays for ALL pupils so please support your child at home with this. The presentation of homework must be clear and written in pencil.
