Mother's Day Lunches – Year 5

Dear Parents

We are really excited about welcoming our mothers, grandmothers, aunts and other female family members in celebration of Mother's Day starting on Monday 16th March through to Tuesday 24th March.

To ensure that everything runs as smoothly as possible, I would like to explain what the lunchtime arrangements are:

- The Key Stage 1 gates will be opened at 11.45am and pupils will meet their parents at 11.50am.
- Mrs Foster will welcome adults into school and provide all visitors with a visitor's badge and tick off all names.
- Adults will be encouraged to wait outside the reception area or under the shelter should we have wet weather and the children will be brought around to meet all adults before children lead them to the side door of the hall at 11.50am.
- Children who don't have an adult with them will have lunch at the same time as the rest of the class and Mr Adams and other teachers will have lunch with these children.
- Upon completion of the meal, adults will be able to leave the school by the Key Stage 1 gates as the children will go out to play.

Please can I ask you to complete the reply slip overleaf and return it to your child's class teacher as soon as possible as it will enable our kitchen staff to order provisions and cater for exact numbers. Please can you make payments through the usual system via Parent Pay (no cash please). If your child is in Key Stage 1, then there is no charge for the meal for the children but adults are requested to pay **£2.75** for their meal. The cost of a junior meal is **£2.29**, but if your child does not usually pay for school meals then please just pay for the adult meal.

We look forward to welcoming as many of you as possible and please can I ask that the form overleaf is returned **no later than Monday 9th March** as no more orders will be able to be processed after this date. Thanking you in advance for your co-operation with this.



School Meal Price Increase From Wednesday 1st April 2020

Since joining Mellors Catering we have been delighted with the food, choice, flexibility and feedback from the children, and the number of children having school dinners has also increased. However, from time to time, suppliers need to make their product financially viable and because of this, Mellors Catering (not the school) have informed us that after their annual review of catering costs, they have had to make the decision to increase the cost of school dinners by 10p a day – this is due to the increase in the National Living Wage and inflation rise on food and consumables. Please be aware that the new price will therefore be £2.39 per meal and this price increase will take effect from **Wednesday 1st April**.
