




I am going to Shobnall Primary School

and welcomes you in.**




**This is the door to the

You place your water bottle on the ‘water bottle’ trolley. At the end of the day, you take it home to get it cleaned and refilled, ready for the next day.



This is our class Reading Area.

Every morning you choose a library book to take home. When you have read it, your grown-up helper will write it in your very own reading diary.

Your book bag and reading diary go in these boxes.



You will be given a special reading certificate each half term, depending on the number of times you read your books at home each week.

When you come into the classroom each morning you will need to choose your school dinner option. Collect your name card and place it into one of the boxes:

Option 1 is a meat choice

Option 2 is a vegetarian choice

Option 3 is a packed lunch or jacket potato

Option 4 indicates that you bring your own packed lunch



You will all have a named drawer in the classroom to store any pictures you make or to put your jumper/cardigan in if you get too hot.



We ask that you don't bring any toys to school from home because we know that you would get very upset if they got lost or broken!
