1. Welcome	T Farrington	Mrs Farrington welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2. Discuss what the children understand by the word bullying. Do they know the different types of bullying?	T Farrington	Lots of discussion was generated and ideas written on a large piece of paper. These included: Being constantly mean. Told you're not good enough. Talking about someone behind their back. Pushing or hitting someone. It makes you feel sad. Cyberbullying – being unkind through social media. We looked at the definition used by the Anti-Bullying Alliance and talked about examples of physical, verbal, emotional and cyberbullying.
3. Look at the bullying roles cartoon. How could this be promoted during Anti-Bullying Week?	T Farrington	Anti-Bullying Ambassadors are keen to share this in class and to promote the role of the 'Defender'. LS commented that 'If we are all defenders there should be no one who is a target or a ringleader at school!'
4. Anti-bullying Week 'United Against Bullying'	T Farrington	Odd Socks Day Monday 16th November. Explore in each class what bullying is and devise a definition as well as promises that the children will make. This will be our anti-bullying class contracts. All classes to look at the peer defender role and to design a poster. These can then be displayed around school.
