OUR OFFER

Breakfast Club

Our breakfast club runs from 7.30am to 8.45am, Monday to Friday.

The club is fully supervised by our staff, providing a safe and fun start to the day. Our club includes activities such as games, reading, "Wake Up, Shake Up" to name but a few.

There is a choice of breakfast cereals, toast and preserves and also a selection of fruit daily. Drinks are available for your child. Breakfast is at an additional cost (see pricing list).

After School Club

Our **after school club** runs from 3.30pm to 6pm, Monday to Friday. Once again the club is fully supervised where the children are encouraged to have fun and learn through playbased activities, indoor and outdoor. In summer, we recommend children bring sunhats and sun cream for hot weather and in winter, warm clothing.

Those children who are attending any of our extra-curricular clubs can be taken to their chosen clubs or go independently if they are mature enough and if they are attending Shobnall Stars after their club, we will ensure they are collected and are registered to our care after their club finishes.

During Shobnall Stars, the children are free to choose from a selection of both planned and unplanned activities which enhance the provision. Resources are readily available, which include arts and crafts, colouring and drawing, board games, construction, role play, physical play and quiet areas for reading and homework etc.

There are also themed nights based on Christmas, Easter, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Forest School Day and the celebrations of other cultures and traditions, where the children can all get creative.

On certain nights, we host a 'cinema' night where there will be an option of a DVD; a treat for the children to chill and enjoy a film – maybe even with some homemade popcorn!

At Shobnall, we recognise the importance of healthy eating. Fruit is always available for children to access.

BREAKFAST CLUB - 7.30am to 8.45am

£4.00 per child to attend

Plus £1.00 additional cost for provision of breakfast

NB: Breakfast will finish being served at 8.15am.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUB – 3.30pm to 6.00pm

3.30pm to 5.00pm	-	£5.00 per child
3.30pm to 6.00pm	-	£7.00 per child

Children have access to fruit, drinks and biscuits and are able to bring their own food if they wish.

AD HOC SESSIONS

All Ad Hoc Sessions will be charged at the above prices, with an additional £2.00 charge. If a session is booked with *less than 24 hours notice*, this constitutes as an Ad Hoc Session.

LATE FEE

A £5.00 surcharge will be applied to all parents who collect after 6.00pm, when Shobnall Stars officially closes. [All policy documents are available on our website].

ALL PAYMENTS TO BE MADE VIA PARENT PAY

These changes will come into effect from **September 2021**.

BOOKING FORM



All bookings should be made one week in advance to ensure we have the correct staff:pupil ratios in situ. Bookings can be made via email at: shb-wraparound@shb.jtmat.co.uk. Please note that emails are checked:

- Monday to Friday, between 7.30am and 9.00am
- Monday to Friday between 3.30pm and 6.00pm

Emails are NOT checked at weekends.

All payments to be made via **Parent Pay.** Unfortunately, we do not have the facilities to be able to take payment via any other method.

Shobnall Stars staff will complete the Club Register for all children attending both Breakfast Club and After School Club and will cross reference all payments made on the system with attendance and drop off/collection times.

Upon admission to Shobnall Stars, every person with parental responsibility will be required to complete a series of registration forms. On attending your first session, a member of staff will support you with completing this documentation.

These documents will be handed to you for completion upon receipt of your initial booking form. Alternatively, they can be downloaded from the school website.

FURTHER INFORMATION



- We will ensure that we obtain ongoing feedback from both yourselves and the children to find out which activities they have enjoyed and which you have found beneficial to their learning journey. The interests of our children are central to our aims.
- We will meet any of your child's individual dietary or specific requirements and preferences where possible. However, if your child would like any alternatives, these can be sent into school on the day and you are, of course, welcome to send your child with their own snack should you prefer.
- If any child has an accident whilst in our care, as parents, you will be informed when you collect your child, or immediately should there be any concerns regarding the injury. We will follow all the policies and procedures in situ for Shobnall Stars.
- All documents and policies are available on the school website. Please keep your eyes on the website for further details and for an insight into what exciting activities we intend to plan for your child/children. Prizes will also be awarded to children when participating in games.
