When you come to school in the morning you will wait outside these black gates, until a member of staff opens them up and welcomes you in.

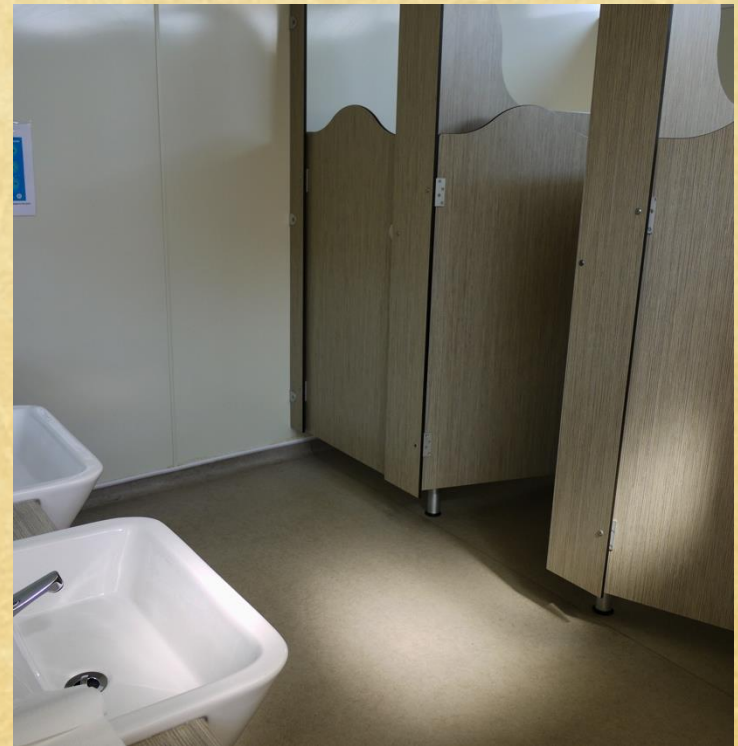


This is the door to the Reception Classroom.
