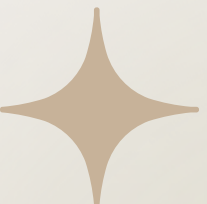

Maths



- Place value - 10's and 1's
- Adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers
- Properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Money
- Multiplication and division (2's, 5's, 10's and 3's)
- Length, height, capacity and mass
- Fractions - $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$
- Tell the time to the 5 minute
- Problem solving
- Position and direction
- Statistics

Writing



- Spelling rules
- Suffixes (-ed, -est, -ing, -ful, -ment, -ness and -ly).
- Using conjunctions (and, but, so, because, if, when).
- Using commas in a list.
- Using apostrophes (don't, couldn't, can't, etc..)
- Using possessive apostrophes.
- Writing narratives.
- Non-chronological reports
- Letters, dairies and instructions
- Information texts

PE



- PE will be on Wednesdays.
- Children will need to come to school in their kit
- An outdoor kit should consist of plain black or navy jogging bottoms, a plain black or navy sweatshirt and trainers.
- For health and safety, children who wear earrings should have these removed on PE days.

Assessment



- You will have noticed I have not called it SATs.
- The government have decided to make Year 2 SATs optional and this is the first year.
- The JTMAAT are wanting to take an academy approach.
- It is not yet confirmed.
- Each term standardised assessments are used to support teacher judgement.
- There will be some kind of teacher moderation and if there is a more formal assessment this is just further evidence to back my judgement.
- We will update you with more information when it has been decided as an academy.
