Key Information

Each week, Year 4 children will receive homework which is handed out on Fridays. This will consist of a piece of English or Maths homework, spellings to learn (which will be loaded onto Spelling Shed every week), a times table to learn for a Friday test and also reading. The children are expected to read **at least three times** every week. All Year 4 children will take part in the National Multiplication Check in June 2021. Times Tables Rock Stars will help your child to learn their times tables.

PE will be on **Wednesdays**. Children will need to come to school in their kit on their allocated day. An **outdoor kit should consist of** jogging bottoms, a sweatshirt and trainers. For health and safety, children who wear earrings should have these removed on PE days.

Year 4 Multiplication Check

- Year 4 have a national test – Times tables test in June.
- To prepare for this, we will be doing lots of work in class as well as timetables being given out for homework.
- Your child will begin on their 2's times tables with a test every Friday. They will be given one minute to answer 12 questions correctly before moving onto a new times table.
- Children have a Times Tables Rockstars password in their reading diary. This will allow the children to practise their times tables at home.
- We will continue 33 club every Friday.

PE and Music

- PE will be taught **EVERY** Wednesday so children will need to come to school in their PE kit.

Homework

- Homework will be given out on a Friday and needs to be handed in on a Wednesday.
- Homework will consist of:
- Weekly spellings – Children are given spellings to learn for a spelling test on a Friday. Spellings will also be in your child's reading diary and on Spelling Shed.
- Times tables to learn for a weekly test on a Friday.
- A piece of Maths or English. Children will be asked which one they would like to choose from the three levels of differentiated homework.
- Reading – Your child should be reading as much as possible to an adult or on their own. Please encourage our child to read at home and write in their reading diary.
- Reading diaries should be handed into school EVERYDAY.
