Research and play outdoor games which would have been played by children in the 1940s. Design and test out a parachute (using a toy or weight) that would allow a member of the RAF to land safely. Visit your local library and find information books on the Second World War. 	 Imagine you have been evacuated. Write a letter home to your parents. Read a Second World War novel and discuss with a friend of family member. Write a biography on a significant individual from the Second World War. Write a newspaper report about a significant event during the Second World War.

Design your own code with a friend and write messages to each other. Talk to relatives about members of your family who were alive during the Second World War.
