This week in Nursery, the children have been looking at sorting and have continued to practice and strengthen their skills of sorting. They have progressed from sorting colours, to talking about differences in size and shape and have now begun sorting by size and shape using a wide a range of resources.

For home learning this week, I would like the children to help sort everyday resources at home. For example - sorting clothes by colour or clothes by person, sorting cutlery (all of the forks go here, all of the spoons here and all of the knives here, sorting toys (soft toys and hard toys). If your child is developmentally ready, they could begin to sort objects by size using the language small, medium and big or identify the shapes of the objects they are sorting (all the circle objects here, all the squares ones here).
