This week in Nursery we have been learning to name and describe some 2D shapes.

Let's go on a shape hunt!



Can you find something around your house that is shaped like a square, rectangle, circle and triangle shape? I would like the children to talk about the properties of the shapes they see in the environment. Can they describe the objects using everyday language - flat, curved, hard, bumpy, soft, smooth, straight, long, short etc, and for some children they may use some mathematical vocabulary such as the number of straight or curved 'edges' that a 2D shape has.

Extension: If there is a 2D shape your child is not so familiar with, they could create a shape person and name it Miss Rectangle, for example.
