

English	<p><u>Reading</u> Read at home on at least three separate occasions. Reading diaries are to be filled in every time your child has read and handed in daily.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> To promote spelling both in school and at home, we are involved in an online programme called 'Spelling Shed'. You will need to use your child's login details, which are stuck in their homework book.
